“AHERA” Annual Notification Letter

Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) in 1986. This act concerns asbestos in schools. As of a result of this act, our facility was inspected for asbestos containing building materials and the condition was assessed and a remediation plan was put into place. The materials are re-inspected and re-assessed every three years.

We continue to monitor the conditions of these materials through our on going six-month surveillance program. It is our district’s intent to comply with federal, state, and local regulations governing asbestos to ensure a safe environment for our students, staff, and visitors. A copy of our district’s Asbestos Management Plan is available at our administrative offices during regular school hours.
