The candidate should be experienced in building academic skills for students, creating an effective classroom, and developing small group and individual lessons. The ideal candidate must work collaboratively with team members and must possess excellent written and verbal communication skills.

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**Essential Qualifications:**

- Possession of a Georgia Teaching Certificate in CTAE fields of Computer Science or Engineering and/or a Georgia Professional Certificate in Instructional Technology or willingness to obtain any of the above
- Ability to entice and encourage middle and high school students to the field of technology
- Ability to mentor teachers regarding the use of technology in the classroom
- Experience with teaching computer science or related fields to middle and/or high school students
- Positive, inclusive, and welcoming attitude
- Enthusiastic, creative, flexible approach to teaching
- Ability to differentiate methodology to accommodate learning differences
- Sound classroom management skills
- Team player: ability to collaborate well with other members of the school community
- Experience working with diverse populations of students, including gifted and those on the autism spectrum
- Excellent communication skills including listening, speaking, and writing
- Understanding of standards for Engineering Drafting and Design and Game Design as part of the Georgia Department of Education CTAE pathways
